
Puzzle 13: Broken Mirror

Oh no! Everyone knows that breaking a mirror condemns the guilty to seven years of bad luck! Maybe if you can put things back together, you'll only lose an hour or so of your time? With your puzzle materials you will find eighteen "one-sided" pentominoes (you should work with all of the pieces so that they show the reflective side upward). It would be a great accomplishment if you could assemble the pieces back into one or more of the three looking-glass shapes here:



I'll reward you for each figure you can form. Show me, in person (not an emailed photo), the assembled solutions to any of the above and earn 50 Points for each. You may solve them one at a time; you do not need to have all three solved to get credit for one or two of them.

Note that this puzzle does not require the discovery or submission of Symbol-Codes.

And again, none of the pieces may be flipped over (you should see the reflective side when you are solving).
